RESERVATION POLICY

Before you call, please have the following information:

1. **First 4 digits of your NLL member number**
2. **Arrival and departure dates.**
3. **Pen and paper to write down your confirmation number!**

All reservations can only be made by phone and must be during business hours (9am-5pm). No phone message or email reservations will be accepted, as you need to get a verbal confirmation number.

Reservations must be made for all U.S. and Canadian Holidays/Special Events. The first call dates to make reservations for given Holidays/Special Events are listed. Please remember that reservations **CANNOT BE MADE DURING ANY HOLIDAY / SPECIAL EVENT WEEKENDS.**

CANCELLATION POLICY

Members must cancel their reservations within 72 hours (3 days) of the holiday weekend. If a member does not cancel their reservations, that member will not be allowed to make reservations for any future holidays at NLL for 1 (one) year. The member who does not cancel will be allowed in only on a space available basis. "No Shows" for holidays at NLL will not be acceptable. Be courteous to your fellow members and cancel your reservations if you can't be here. When you cancel a reservation, please write down your cancellation number provided.

FIREWOOD

BUY LOCAL, BURN LOCAL

The New York law now states that the transportation of firewood is to be less than 50 miles from Lazy Lakes Resort or your camping destination.

1. Buy your wood at Lazy Lakes, or
2. Purchase it locally within 50 miles or less of Lazy Lakes and you must provide a receipt that shows the address, phone number and a contact person of where you purchased it.
3. NYS DEC Agr. & Markets will be stopping RVs, writing tickets and issuing fines. Make sure you have full documentation for your firewood.

LOCAL POINTS OF INTEREST

OLD FORT NIAGARA

Boasting three centuries of history constructed by the French in 1726. Fort Niagara's original stone buildings have been preserved to look as they did before the American Revolution. This popular tourist attraction, which also features picnic and swimming facilities, is open year 'round and is easily reached by following the Robert Moses Parkway north to the Village of Youngstown.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA SHRINE

Supervised by the Barnabite Fathers, The Shrine features a 15-acre "outdoor cathedral," more than 90 life-size marble statues of Saints, a giant rosary and a dome of the world, topped by a 13 foot granite statue. It is open year 'round and is illuminated at night.

NIAGARA POWER PROJECT VISITOR CENTER

Located within the Town of Lewiston. This facility is popular with area educational facilities as a learning tool, as well as being a favorite with tourists. The visitor center includes an animated power plant, terrain maps, transmission line models, slides & motion pictures.

LEWISTON HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Located on the corner of Niagara and Plain Streets, in the Village of Lewiston. Open from 1-5pm Wed thru Sun, it depicts the rich history of this area.

AQUARIUM OF NIAGARA FALLS

SCHOELLKOPF GEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

New York State's multimedia museum explains the 500 million year geological history of the Falls. Accessible by walkway across from Aquarium.

UNDERGROUND BOAT RIDE

It's taken 4 million years, but a piece of nearby geography is getting some long overdue attention. The Lockport Cave Tour is full of "history & mystery". The historical significance of the Erie Canal and manufacturing industry to the spectacular scenery make this a "must do" 1-1/2 hour exciting & informative tour. LOCKPORT LOCKS & ERIE CANAL CRUISES

Imagine cruising the famous Erie Canal. You will pass beautiful historic buildings and the serene canal shore. This narrated cruise through the Lockport locks is done on one of two vessels. The Lockview IV, or V.

Each vessel has its own licensed captain. Besides taking a historic canal cruise, you might wish to visit the Canal Side Emporium. The Emporium is located in a four story 1840's stone warehouse overlooking the canal. The Emporium offers dining, gift shop, picnic grove, the Lift Bridge Cafe & Pub and a great banquet facility for any possible special occasion. This truly unique and historic facility offers so much more than we listed, you must put this on your list of important and exciting things to do when visiting Niagara's Lazy Lakes and western New York. 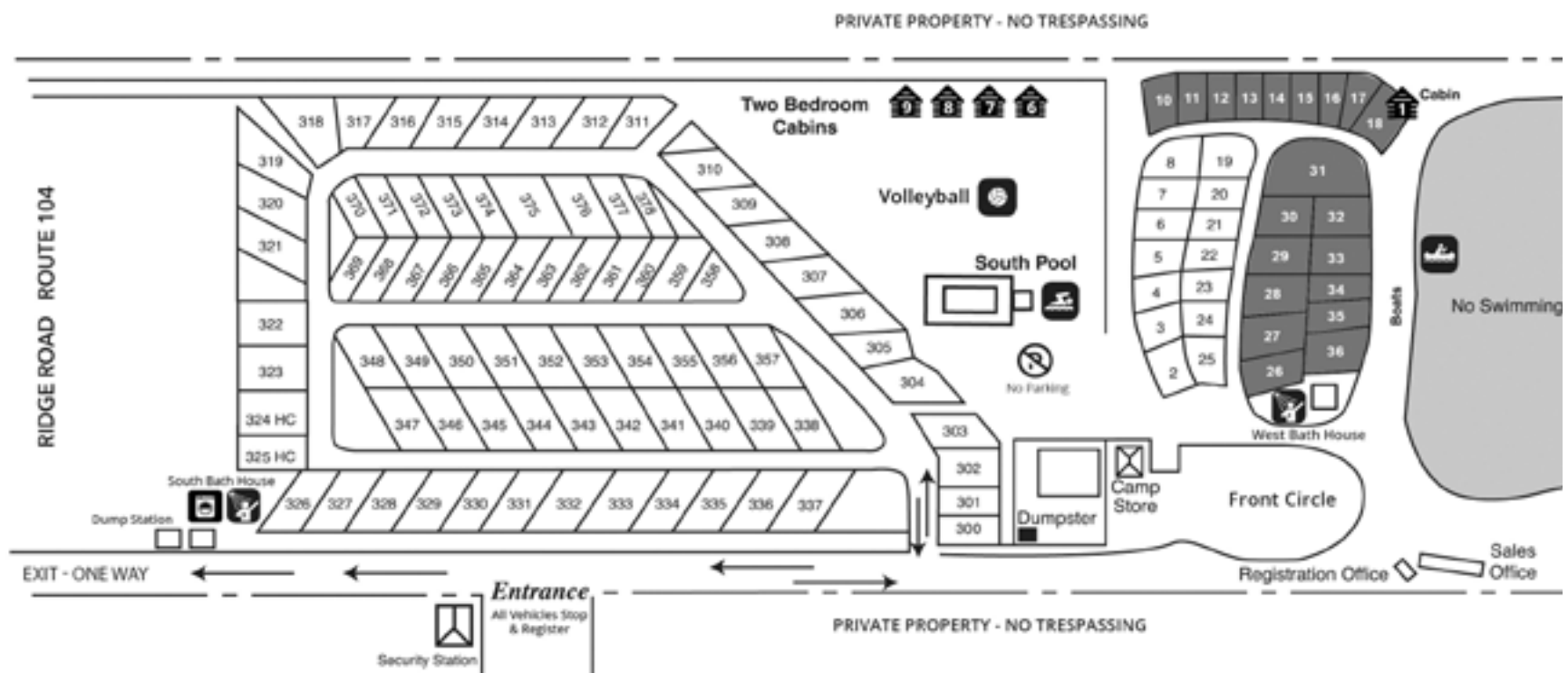

NIAGARA'S LAZY LAKES RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Members must observe all signs and obey all special local rules established by the Resort Manager for the smooth operation of the Resort.
- All vehicles must stop at Security and register for arrival and departure. All RVs must park on RV sites. NO reserving campsites by you or your guest.
- Campfires may only be burned in designated fire rings within the campsite area, unless hazardous fire conditions require a prohibition of fires by the Resort Manager. NO boards or pallets with nails will be allowed to be burned in fire rings.
- Members may not cut the natural vegetation or in any way vandalize the Resort.
- No fire arms or fireworks are allowed on Lazy Lakes Resort property.
- All debris and garbage must be bagged and placed in the dumpster located east of the store on the Resort's entrance road, not on campsite.
- Quiet times are in effect from 10pm to 9am daily. Please respect your neighbors.
- Members must clean fire rings and general grounds surrounding their campsite after use. Do not burn garbage in fire rings.
- In the case of an emergency, Lazy Lakes Resort is authorized to move any member's RV equipment or vehicle without notice or liability.
- Adult areas may only be used by members who are 18 years of age or older.
- Pets are to be kept on a leash at all times and under the control of their owner, or kept inside the member's RV. Pets may not enter building or beach areas under any circumstances. Exotic pets and pit bulls are not allowed on the Resort. Unruly pets must be removed from NLL property.
- Members' and guests' use of all NLL facilities is done so at their own risk. NLL is not responsible for loss or damage to property of members or guests.
- Any member/guest that willfully or negligently defaces, burglarizes or destroys property/equipment of NLL, or of another member or guest, will be held liable for the full value thereof and may have their membership suspended and/or terminated.
- Camping vehicles must not be left unattended overnight without permission of the Resort Manager. If found unattended without authorization, vehicle can be towed at member's/guest's expense.
- The speed limit throughout the Resort is 5 miles per hour, which will be strictly enforced. Violators will be asked to leave.
- Fishing and swimming will be done at the guest and members own risk. The buddy system is suggested at all times. Members must accompany all children under the age of 10, while swimming. Guests/members must observe all posted regulations. Fishing is catch and release only.
- Throughout the resort, all children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult after 10:00pm.
- No clotheslines will be allowed on the Resort. Towels and swimsuits may be hung from your awning. No other laundry.
- Washing of automobiles or RV's on the Resort is not permitted without purchasing, in advance, a permit at the camp store.
- No vehicle repairs are to be done on NLL property without written authorization. No oil changes, etc. No vehicles missing mufflers or noisy vehicles allowed.
- Any abuse of other members, guests or company employees may be grounds for suspension pending possible termination of camping privileges.
- No storage on site or under RV (i.e. refrigerator, freezers, ladders, etc.).
- No soliciting of any kind will be done on the Resort. Sale of any items will only be allowed during designated times and in designated areas.
- One tent is permitted per campsite. Screen tents must have open bottoms as to not kill the lawn. After 48 hours, your tent must be moved to a different location on your site so it will not kill the grass. All outdoor carpets and mats must fit within your stone pad. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- NY State Health Dept. Regulations state that sink, shower and toilet water is not allowed to be drained on the ground or collected outside your RV. Offenders will be asked to leave the Resort. If you see anyone abusing this regulation, please notify our Security at once.
- Any Solicitation of memberships, either your own or someone else's on this Resort will be grounds for immediate termination.
- Shop Lifting: Anyone caught shop lifting will be arrested and prosecuted.
- Any trespassing on neighbor's property will be grounds for suspension and possible termination of all Resort privileges.
- Members must have an active membership card to enter the Resort. No exceptions. Lost cards are \$20.00 to replace.
- The local law requires children under 14 to wear a helmet when biking on this Resort.
- Beach is closed. No swimming allowed.
- NLL does not allow members/guests to operate golf carts or dirt bikes on NLL property. Electric or motorized scooters, etc., are to be used by adults only. No children are allowed on vehicles by themselves or as passengers. Speed limit is 5 mph. Members/guests are responsible for injury to others when using scooters. NLL has the right to prohibit use of scooters, etc., if the above guidelines are not followed. Use of vehicles of any type are at your own risk.
- Boat Usage: Children under 12 years of age are not allowed use of NLL boats/watercraft without being accompanied by an adult. However, children ages 10 and 11 may use NLL boats/watercraft by having their parents sign the authorization form at the store/security office. Proof of age may be required. Life jackets are required for all children under 10 years of age, but recommended for everyone. All members/guests are responsible for their families/guests using all NLL owned equipment/facilities.
- Members may move from one site to another ONLY after FIRST notifying security. NO EXCEPTIONS! PLEASE FOLLOW PROCEDURES.
- Guest Use Fees - All guests of members will pay a \$4.00 per day per person Guest Fee upon arrival. Exceptions are: No fees for primary member, their parents, children or grandchildren. No charges for children under age 6. More than 8 people per site requires prior approval.
- NO mats, rugs or carpets allowed on lawns. NO EXCEPTIONS.

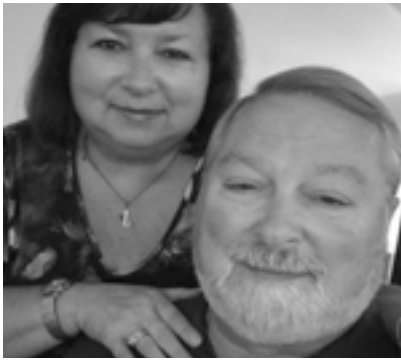

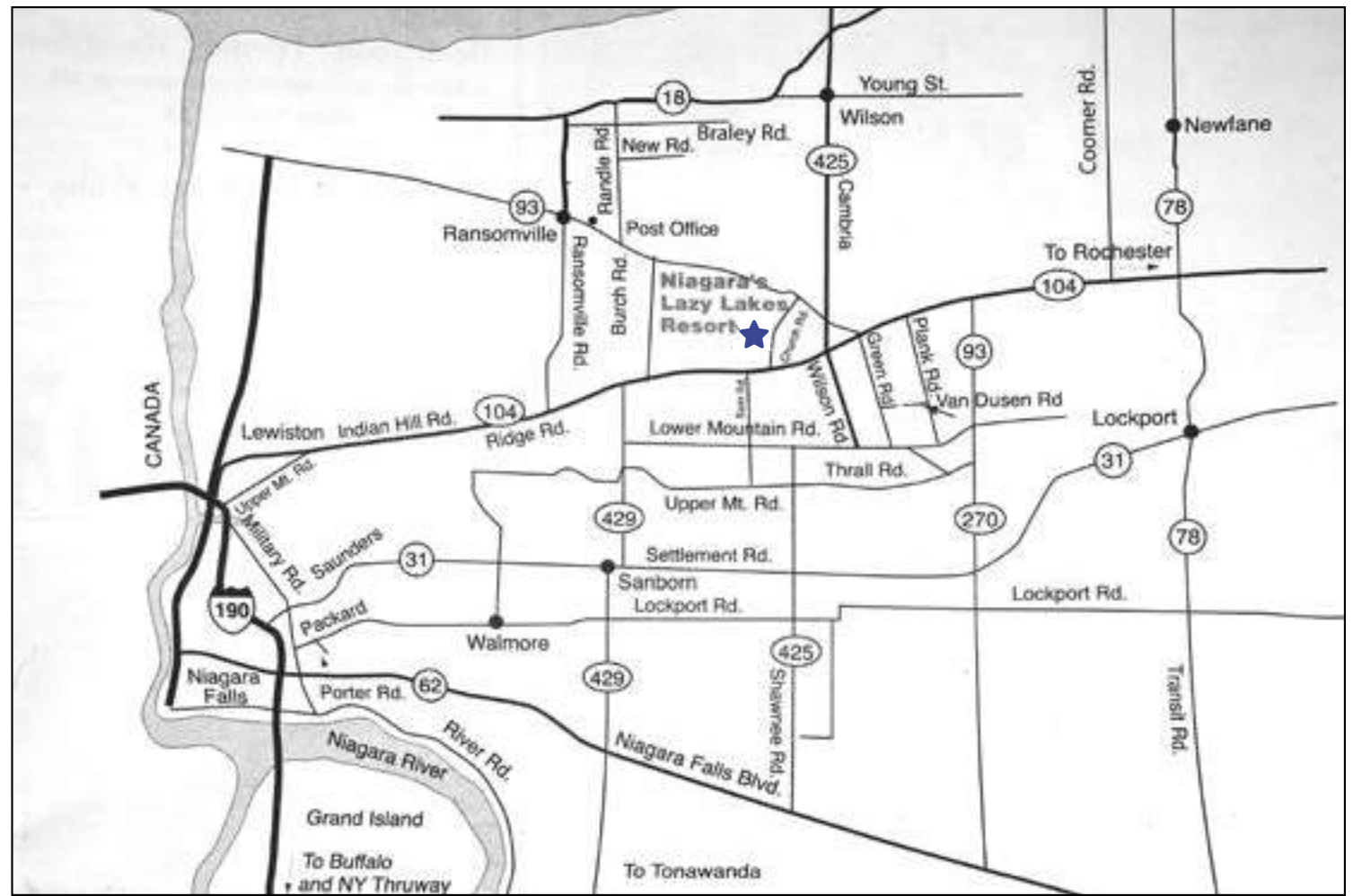
